- Printed images must be delivered to the Consulate-General of Japan in Calgary [Suite 950 517, 10th Avenue, SW, Calgary, AB T2R 0A8] by the submission deadline of July 20th, 2016, at the participant's expense
- Send printed image on photographic paper only
- Printed images must not be mounted or framed
