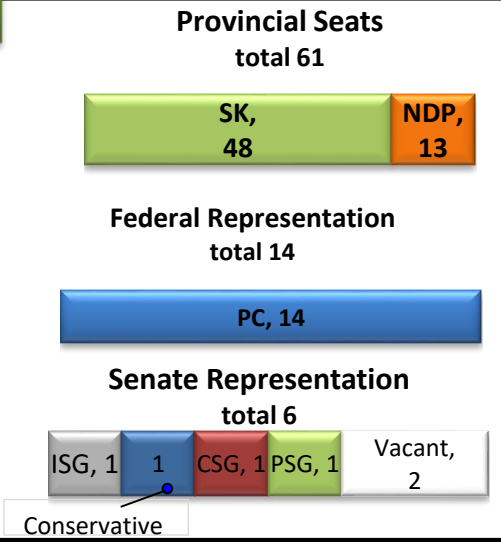

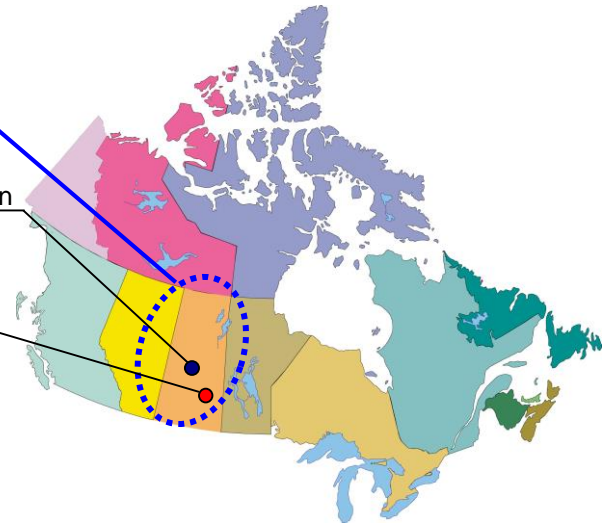

Trade (2019)

- **Exports:** \$1.08 billion to Japan – Key commodities – Canola seed, Wheat and Meslin, Barley, Malt, Soya beans, Alfalfa meal
- **Imports:** \$122.27 million from Japan – Key commodities – Parts of cranes and work-trucks, shovels and excavators, metal casing and pipes

Key Industries

Agriculture: Main commodities – Durum and other wheat (\$3.7 billion exports), Canola Seed (\$2.5 billion exports), Lentils (\$1.1 billion exports), Peas (\$737 million exports); world's largest exporter of mustard, flaxseed and canola
Potash Exports: Largest potash producer in the world (\$6.5 billion exports)
Oil and Gas Exports: 2nd largest O&G producer in Canada (\$8 billion exports)
